

**How to Record and Submit Video Performance for the
Jason Sipe Prize Performers Recital
Online Competition 2021**

SET-UP

- Videos cannot be recorded earlier than 2 weeks prior to submission deadline and must be submitted no later than April 3rd, 2021 by 11:59PM.
- Performance must be on a well-tuned, ACOUSTIC (upright or grand) piano.
- Students must wear appropriate performance attire (For example, dress shirt and pants for boys, dress or skirt to knees or longer or slacks and a nice blouse for girls. Don't forget shoes).
- The device/camera recording the video submission should not be held by hand but rather propped up on a stable surface, tripod, or a stand. Record the video landscape/horizontal view.
- The competitors face, hands, and feet must be clearly visible from the side.
- Because the videos will be combined into one recital video, please ensure that your video is being recorded at the highest quality on your device or camera at approximately 30fps.
- .MP4 files are highly preferred but .MOV files can be accepted.

PERFORMANCE

- Please record the competitor sitting quietly for 5-10 seconds before and after each piece.
- Both pieces must be recorded in one take with no editing.
- Students can do as many takes as they would like. Submit your best take.

SUBMITTING

- Two ways to submit the video to preserve quality
 - o 1. Upload your video file to Google Drive, OneDrive or DropBox and share the file with the chairperson.
 - o 2. Attach the video file to email and send to chairperson.
- Students will need to submit PDF files of their scores. All scores must have measure numbers at the beginning of each line.

CONFIRM

- Please look for a confirmation email that the video was received and is in a usable format.
